

Application Process for Medical Marijuana Patients at the Medical Cannabis Club of Guelph

There are 3 ways to become a member of our club. Please complete the one that is most appropriate to you. You can (1) Have your doctor fill out our "MCCG Application Package", or (2) Have the compassion club you are already a member of fax us your medical records and confirmation of your good member standing, or (3) Provide a copy of your Health Canada permit or properly completed MMAR forms.

Health Canada forms (B1 or B2) provide a patient with a legal possession permit and generally take 2 – 6 months to process. The MCCG Application Package provides the patient with an access card to obtain their supply, and generally takes 2 – 5 days to process (the access card is NOT a legal permit). A referral from another club will provide you with an access card only. Federal permit are an independent process.

How to Complete the Health Canada forms:

note: You do NOT need to complete every form.

-Make sure you bring 2 copies of a standard passport photo of yourself and have your physician sign the back of one of them. This is only required for Form B1 or B2.

- 1) Form B1 – This can be completed by any physician for the following conditions: MS, cancer, HIV/AIDS, spinal cord injury/disease, epilepsy, severe arthritis.
- 2) Form B2 – This form can be completed by any physician, however you must have consulted a specialist in a specialty relevant to the condition being signed for. Form B2 is to be completed for any condition not listed on the B1 form above. Example: a psychiatrist is a specialist for anxiety.
- 3) Medical Cannabis Club of Guelph application form – This form can be completed by any physician, and allows the patient to begin accessing cannabis as a medicine while they are in the process of obtaining a possession permit

Once the appropriate forms above have been signed by the physician, please fax them to our office so we can set up an orientation with the patient and go over the additional paperwork. *There are forms A through E, some of which the patient needs to complete before mailing the package off but none of them can be completed until the above physician forms are completed and verified.
